

## Features of Folding Camp Chairs You May Want To Consider Before Purchasing Your Next Camping Chair

- Folding Camp Chairs come in a **variety of colors**. If you are using your chair while hunting or fishing you may want to consider a camouflage colored folding chair. Then, of course, there are the traditional colors of red, green, blue, black, purple and orange camp chairs.
- What is the **weight capacity** of the camp chair you are considering. A large number of the camping chairs found in stores only support up to around 300 lbs. in weight. However, if you look online you will find folding camp chairs with larger seats and sturdier frames that can support 500 lbs., 600 lbs. and even up to 1000 lbs. in weight capacity.
- How much does the **folding chair itself weigh**? If you plan to haul your camp chair around in the truck of the car or carrying it on your back while hiking then you will most certainly want to consider the weight of the chair you choose to purchase. There are a number of folding aluminum lightweight chairs that will fit nicely in a backpack.
- What is the **height of the back of the chair**? If you are tall yourself then a high back chair may be more comfortable for you to sit in. However, if you are planning on using your chair at concerts it may be taller than the height restrictions allowed at outdoor concert events.
- **Height from the ground** on the folding camp chair you are viewing. Many of the [low to ground chairs](#) are used for outdoor concert events because they do not block the view of the people behind you and you won't necessarily need a table because you can easily just sit your drink on the ground. Some chairs have adjustable heights they may just give you the best of both worlds.
- Speaking of drinks, many chairs offer **drink holders** in the armrest and also a hanging cooler pouch for extra drinks. If you like to drink a lot and don't want to be constantly getting up to get another drink then you would certainly enjoy this type folding camp chair.

- For those who like to **recline** and maybe snooze in their folding chair then there are a number of choices of folding camping chairs that recline. Pay attention to the number of reclining positions. Some will recline to a totally flat position and others won't recline that far.
- If you like the idea of reclining you may also want one with a **footrest**. Some even have detachable footrests.
- Many people like the **folding director's chairs** because of the side table. People who attend vendor shows, are artists, makeup artists, etc. like the tall version of the director's chairs. This allows them to sit and be more at eye level with their clients or visitors. If you are a bird watcher then you may like having the side table to hold your binoculars, notebooks, etc.
- Folding camp / beach chairs with a **canopy** are enjoyed by those who love to sit on the beach in the sun. The canopy can not only shield you from the hot sun it gives a little protection from dew or a light rain.
- Rocking is such a relaxing, low stress exercise. For those who like to rock, but don't want the hassle of a heavy rocker then consider these [camping rocking chairs](#) for outdoors or your porch area.
- Some folding chairs have canvas armrests and others have a **hard armrest**. I think this is just a personal preference with people.
- If you are going to be carrying your folding camp chair a lot then don't forget to look for one with **a carry strap or a carrying bag**. Will make lugging it around so much easier.
- **Padded headrests** are nice and make for head comfort. Something like the ALPS Mountaineering Ultimate Recliner has a nice padded headrest that you might enjoy.
- If you have a lot of small items you want to keep at hand while sitting outdoors in your folding chair then look for one with the attached **mesh storage bags** and / or cell phone protectors. Store your glasses / sunglasses, pens, paper, magazines, etc. in these bags so they are quick at hand while relaxing outdoors.
- For those who have had a **back injury or have constant back pain** many of the folding camp chairs are padded and offer a good lumbar

support. Something like the KingCamp Folding Chair with Lumbar Support is a good choice for those with lower back pain.

- Maybe you just need to sit a bit while doing your gardening or at different spots at your favorite fishing hole, then something like the GCI Quik-E-Seat ***folding tripod field chair*** with backrest would be all you need. With its Auto-Fold Technology shoulder strap it allows for easy opening, closing and carrying while giving you a quick rest at most any spot.

Folding camping chairs are so handy and fulfill many needs. They are great for camping, tailgating, fishing, hunting, outdoor concerts, sports events, trade shows, artists and certainly just lounging on the beach or in your own backyard.
